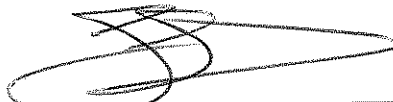
consent to disbarment freely and voluntarily and not under coercion or intimidation. I am aware of the Rules of the Supreme Court of Arizona regarding discipline, disbarment, disability, resignation and reinstatement, and I understand that any future application by me for admission or reinstatement as a member of the State Bar of Arizona will be treated as an application by a member who has been disbarred for professional misconduct.

The misconduct of which I am accused of in the above-numbered charge is described in my letter dated March 13, 2013, and attached Plea Agreement along with my letter dated April 18, 2013, and attached Stipulated Statement of Facts, copies which are attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and Exhibit "B", respectively.¹

A proposed form of Judgment of Disbarment is attached hereto as Exhibit "D".

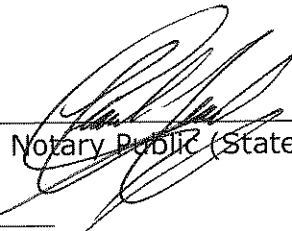
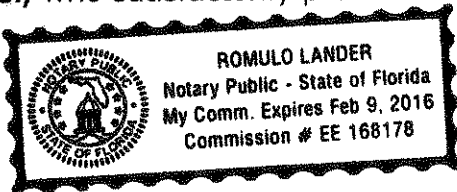

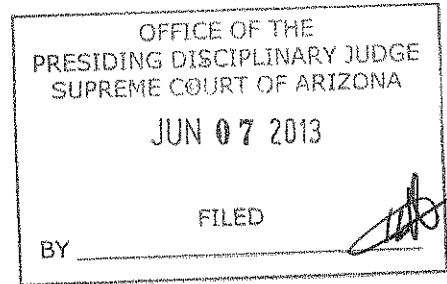

JUDGMENT OF DISBARMENT

State Bar No. 13-0525

Pursuant to Rule 57, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., the Presiding Disciplinary Judge of the Supreme Court of Arizona has considered Respondent's Consent to Disbarment and Costs dated May 29, 2013 and filed June 3, 2013.

Accordingly:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED accepting the consent to disbarment. Respondent **Scott F. Saidel, Bar No. 016296**, is hereby disbarred from the State Bar of Arizona and his name is hereby stricken from the roll of lawyers, **effective immediately**. Respondent is no longer entitled to the rights and privileges of a lawyer but remains subject to the jurisdiction of the court. Respondent shall immediately comply with the requirements relating to notification of clients and others, and provide and/or file all notices and affidavits required by Rule 72, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no further disciplinary action shall be taken in reference to the matters that are the subject of the complaint upon which the consent to disbarment and this judgment of disbarment are based.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent pay the costs and expenses of the State Bar of Arizona in the amount of \$1,200.00.
