**CONSENT TO
DISBARMENT**

[State Bar No. 11-3207]

I, **Raymond L. Miller**, residing at 1820 E. Ray Road, Chandler, Arizona 85225, voluntarily consent to disbarment as a member of the State Bar of Arizona and consent to the removal of my name from the roster of those permitted to practice before this court, and from the roster of the State Bar of Arizona.

I acknowledge that a formal complaint has been filed against me. I have read the complaint, and the charges there made against me. I further acknowledge that I do not desire to contest or defend the charges, but wish to consent to disbarment. I have been advised of and have had an opportunity to exercise my right to be represented in this matter by a lawyer. I consent to disbarment freely and voluntarily and not under coercion or intimidation. I am aware of the rules of the Supreme Court with respect to discipline, disability, resignation and reinstatement, and I understand that any future application by me for admission or reinstatement as a member of the State Bar of Arizona will be treated as an

application by a member who has been disbarred for professional misconduct, as set forth in the complaint filed against me. The misconduct of which I am accused is described in the complaint bearing the number referenced above, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

I agree that I cannot defend the alleged violations of Rule 42, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., specifically E.R.s 1.2(a), 1.3, 1.4, 1.5(c), 5.4, 8.4(b), 8.4(c) but only as to the allegation that I converted and misappropriated client funds, 1.15(a), 1.15(d) and Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. 43(a), 43(b)(1)(A), 43(b)(2)(A), 43(b)(2)(B), 43(b)(2)(C), 43(b)(2)(D), 43(b)(1)(C), 43(b)(5), 54(a), and 54(d)(2)(C). The State Bar agrees for purposes of this Consent to Disbarment to dismiss its allegations that I violated Rule 42, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., specifically E.R.s 8.4(c), as it relates to my communications with the Department of Veteran Affairs and as it relates to my statements to the State Bar that my practice moved away from personal injury matters, and ER 5.5(a).

In addition, I consent to pay restitution to the following persons in the following amounts: (1) Thomas Rothchild in the amount of \$46,250.00; (2) Jangie Hidey in the amount of \$8,966.67; and (3) Tiffany Campbell in the amount of \$5,031.54.

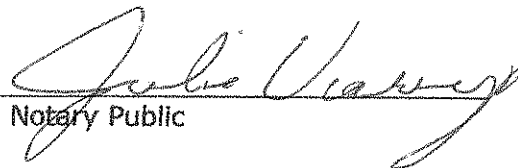
I further consent to pay the cost of these proceedings in the amount specified in the Statement of Costs, attached hereto as Exhibit "B".

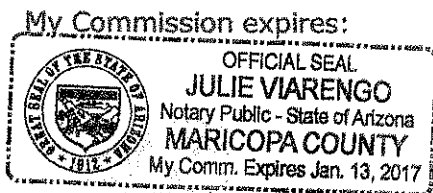

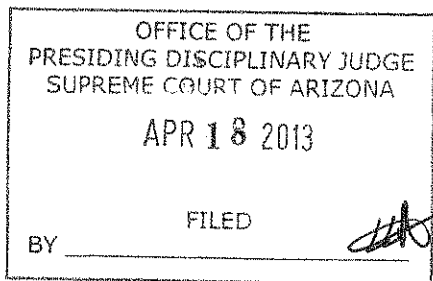

JUDGMENT OF DISBARMENT

[State Bar No. 11-3207]

Pursuant to Rule 57, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., the undersigned Presiding Disciplinary Judge of the Supreme Court of Arizona has considered Respondent's Consent to Disbarment dated April 10, 2013, and filed herein. Accordingly:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED accepting the consent to disbarment. Respondent, Raymond L. Miller, is hereby disbarred from the State Bar of Arizona and his name is hereby stricken from the roll of lawyers. Respondent is no longer entitled to the rights and privileges of a lawyer but remains subject to the jurisdiction of the court. Respondent shall immediately comply with the requirements relating to notification of clients and others, and provide and/or file all notices and affidavits required by Rule 72, Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that no further disciplinary action shall be taken in reference to the matters that are the subject of the charges upon which the consent to disbarment and this judgment of disbarment are based.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent pay restitution to the following persons in the following amounts: (1) Thomas Rothchild in the amount

of \$46,250.00; (2) Jangie Hidey in the amount of \$8,966.67; and (3) Tiffany Campbell in the amount of \$5,031.54.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent pay the costs and expenses of the State Bar of Arizona in the amount of \$2,274.80.
