## In the Matter of Alan A. Waugh, Bar No. 025290; No. 10-0929. 02/28/2011.

Attorney Suspended For Six Months and One Day, plus two years probation.

Following an Aggravation/ Mitigation Hearing conducted pursuant to Rule 58(d) of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court as a result of default being entered against Respondent, the Hearing Panel suspended Alan A. Waugh, Bar No. 025290 for six months and one day effective February 28, 2011. Respondent failed to represent his client with reasonable diligence and promptness, neglected to appear for court hearings or to inform his client of those court hearings. Respondent failed to confer or inform his client of stipulations he had entered and then failed to sign the stipulations. When terminated he provided a copy of the client file to his client but included documents of another client related to a sex offense criminal matter. Respondent failed to respond to the State Bar inquires. His misconduct admitted by default constituted grounds for the imposition of discipline. He violated Rule 42, E.R. 1.3, 1.4(a)(1), 1.4(a)(3), 1.6(a), 1.16(d), 3.4(c), 8.1(b), 8.4(a) and Rule 54(d), Ariz.R.Sup.Ct.
