## In the Matter of Alfonso Roberto Trujillo, Bar No. 021619; Charge Nos. 10-792, 10-1322; 2-14-2011

On February 14, 2011, pursuant to Rule 58(d) of the Arizona Supreme Court Rules, the hearing panel held an aggravation/mitigation hearing on this matter. Through default, Respondent was deemed to admit to the allegations of the Complaint filed against her.

Following the hearing, the hearing panel disbarred Alfonso Roberto Trujillo (Attorney Bar No. 021619) from the practice of law, effective February 14, 2011. Respondent was conditionally admitted to practice law on May 1, 2007. On June 8, 2010, Respondent was summarily suspended from the practice of law and has not been reinstated. In these matters, Respondent abandoned two separate clients in two separate cases without notice to his clients allowing adverse awards to be entered against each client. Respondent failed and refused to return unexpended costs advanced by each client. Respondent knowingly failed to respond to a lawful demand for information from a disciplinary authority and refused to cooperate with officials and staff of the State Bar.

The conduct of Respondent was a violation of Rule 32(c)3, Rule 42, ER 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.15(d), 1.16(b) and (d), 8.4(c) and (d), and Rule 53(d) and (f) Ariz.R.Sup.Ct
