A Post-Conviction Relief Study Committee was established by Administrative Order No. 91-22 with the purpose of reviewing current court rules and statutes relating to post-conviction relief and recommending to the Supreme Court any changes that should be made in these rules and statutes.

The committee membership appointed in Administrative Order No. 91-22 includes persons from a wide variety of perspectives on post-conviction relief. The original membership included two superior court judges but no appellate judge. The importance of the perspective of an appellate judge to the ongoing work of this committee is now recognized.

IT IS ORDERED that Judge Noel Fidel, Chief Judge, Division I, Arizona Court of Appeals, is appointed as a member of the Post-Conviction Relief Study Committee on the terms indicated in Administrative Order 91-22.
