In the Matter of Robert Blakey, Bar No.: 002934, PDJ 2011-9048, filed December 15, 2011. Attorney Suspended and costs imposed.

Pursuant to Rule 57(a)(4)(A), Ariz.R.Sup.Ct, the PDJ approved the Agreement for Discipline by Consent submitted by the parties and suspended Robert Blakey for 45 days effective January 20, 2012. Upon reinstatement, Respondent either will resign as a member of the State Bar or be placed on supervised probation for two years.

In count one, and while representing a client, Respondent filed two motions to recuse the entire Yavapai County judiciary from hearing his client's matter. In one motion, Respondent accused two judicial officers of engaging in insurance fraud and conspiring to break Arizona law and violate the Cannons of Judicial Conduct based on an evidentiary dispute Respondent had with the two judges in an earlier, unrelated matter.

In count two, Respondent filed an identical motion on behalf of a client's matter three different times after being ordered by the court not to file the motion twice.

Two aggravating factors and six mitigating factors were found. Respondent was found to have violated Rule 41(c) and Rule 42, specifically ERs 3.1, 3.4(c), 4.4(a), and 8.4(d), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct.

The agreement is accepted and costs awarded in the amount of \$1,360.21. The proposed final judgment and order is reviewed, approved and signed.
