

## COURT REVENUE

### Appellate and Superior Courts Narrative Summary

The revenue data provided here is for the appellate and Superior Courts of Arizona. The figures were compiled from probation fee reports and the quarterly revenue surveys submitted to the Supreme Court during FY 1999. Major revenue categories shown represent monies collected from four sources:

**FINES, SANCTIONS, FORFEITURES:** Revenue from monetary penalties assessed in criminal and juvenile matters, and bond monies that were forfeited;

**SURCHARGES:** Revenue from monetary assessments authorized by statute above and beyond criminal penalties and certain civil and other fees;

**FEES:** Revenue from collectible fees for services of the court and chargeable aspects of case processing;

**OTHER REVENUE:** Revenue from sources not otherwise specified.

Total revenue collected by the Supreme Court increased from \$3,813,064 in FY 98 to \$3,974,233 in FY 99, up 4.2%. The majority of this revenue is Defensive Driving and JCEF Diversion fees sent directly to the Administrative Office of the Courts. The revenue for the Court of Appeals (both divisions) decreased from \$285,714 in FY 98 to \$282,567 in FY 99, a decline of 1.1%. Superior Court revenue increased from \$39,607,452 in FY 98 to \$43,671,804 in FY 99, an increase of 10.3%.

On the Superior Court table, Maricopa County accounts for 56.9% of all revenue, followed by Pima County with 17.3%. Fees make up the largest segment of Superior Court revenue, a total of \$32,377,378, or 74.1%. The Fines category is second with \$7,872,980, or 18.0%.

The Annual Trust Money Collection Summary shows that the Arizona Superior Court processed \$171,179,702 in "pass-through" trust monies in FY 99, the majority (53.6%) being child-support payments. Again, most trust money collections were in Maricopa County (65.3%), followed by Pima County (19.2%).

## **COURT EXPENDITURES**

### **Appellate and Superior Courts Narrative Summary**

The expenditure information provided here is for the appellate courts, Superior Court, and probation departments of Arizona. These data were compiled from Supreme Court financial records, program fund reversion reports, and annual expenditure surveys submitted to the Supreme Court for FY 1999. Major expenditure categories shown represent monies expended from five sources:

**PRIMARY BUDGET:** Expenditures of appropriated funds from the court's primary funding source, either the state (Supreme Court and Court of Appeals) or the county (Superior Courts and probation)--categories are kept as general as possible because line-item definitions for the state and counties vary widely;

**STATE FUNDS:** Expenditures of state program monies begun or renewed by the Arizona legislature and distributed to the courts;

**FEDERAL FUNDS:** Expenditures of federal program monies begun or renewed by the U.S. Congress and distributed to the courts (often via state agencies);

**PRIVATE FUNDS:** Expenditures of additional grants from other sources;

**LOCAL FUNDS:** Examples are expenditures from collections authorized by statute to reimburse all or part of the expenses of probation, automation, and other court services.

Total expenditures in the Supreme Court increased from \$32,723,381 in FY 98 to \$36,007,345, an increase of 10.0%. Most of these are costs of the Administrative Office of the Courts associated with the administration of the entire Arizona courts system. The Court of Appeals (both divisions) had a 7.8% decrease in expenditures, from \$10,802,247 in FY 98 to \$9,958,868 in FY 99.

Total expenditures in the Superior Court (including the clerk's office) increased from \$111,625,650 last fiscal year to \$117,907,724 in FY 99, up 5.6%. Primary budget (county) expenditures of \$99,514,837 account for 84.4% of the total expenditures.

Expenditures in Superior Court probation (including adult, juvenile and combined departments, and juvenile detention) increased from \$155,154,914 in FY 98 to \$167,100,474 in FY 99, an increase of 7.7%. State funds expenditures of \$93,825,188 account for over half (56.1%) of the total probation expenditures.

**COURT PERSONNEL**  
**Appellate and Superior Courts Narrative Summary**

This summary shows all appellate court, superior court and adult/juvenile probation positions as of June 30, 1999, including positions funded from both primary and non-primary budget sources. The information was reported by the individual courts in response to the Supreme Court personnel survey mailed in July, 1999.

The total number of persons working full-time in the Supreme Court increased from 314 last fiscal year to 354 in FY 99. Full-time employees in the Court of Appeals (both divisions) did not change numerically, with 132 in both FY 98 and FY 99. Full-time employees in Superior Court (including the clerk's office) increased from 2,372 to 2,413 this fiscal year, an increase of 1.7%. Superior Court Probation (including adult, juvenile, and combined departments) full-time employees increased from 3,268 in FY 98 to 3,503 in FY 99, an 7.2% increase.

The Supreme Court had the services of 457 regular volunteers in FY 99. The Superior Court had the services of 101 regular volunteers, while Superior Court Probation utilized the services of 458 regular volunteers. These people include professionals and non-professionals who serve in many different capacities.

Additionally, the Supreme Court utilized 24,976 hours of temporary personnel assistance. The Superior Court utilized 129,860 hours of temporary personnel assistance, and the Superior Court Probation utilized 82,525 hours of temporary personnel assistance.
