**FINAL JUDGMENT AND
ORDER OF RECIPROCAL
DISCIPLINE**

On March 26, 2021, the Office of the Presiding Disciplinary Judge (PDJ), pursuant to Rules 54(h) and 57(b), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., sent Ms. Monaco notice and a certified copy of her suspension dated December 16, 2020, as imposed by the Supreme Court of Nevada. The State Bar filed its response on April 26, 2021, urging that the substantially similar sanction of suspension and probation be imposed. No response has been filed by Respondent.

Rule 57(B)(3), Ariz. R. Sup. Ct., generally provides that the PDJ “shall impose the identical or substantially similar discipline.” The sanction of suspension and probation is substantially similar to the discipline imposed by the Supreme Court of Nevada.

Now Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Respondent **K. ALEXANDRA MONACO, Bar No. 024485**, is suspended from the practice of law for ninety (90) days, effective immediately.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Ms. Monaco shall be placed on probation for one year, to run concurrently with the one-year stayed suspension imposed by the Supreme Court of Nevada, and subject to the terms imposed by that court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED Ms. Monaco shall pay the State Bar's costs and expenses in the sum of \$1,200.00.
