The Complainant alleged a justice of the peace pro tem provided legal assistance to a relative in a family case.

The role of the Commission on Judicial Conduct is to impartially determine whether a judicial officer has engaged in conduct that violates the Arizona Code of Judicial Conduct or Article 6.1 of the Arizona Constitution. There must be clear and convincing evidence of such a violation in order for the Commission to take disciplinary action against a judicial officer.

The Commission reviewed all relevant available information and concluded there was not clear and convincing evidence of ethical misconduct in this matter. The complaint is therefore dismissed pursuant to Commission Rules 16(a) and 23(a).

Commission member Regina L. Nassen did not participate in the consideration of this matter.

Any court proceedings or matters independently from mine should be handled in the most professional way and with respect which in this formal complaint Judge showed no respect or professionalism and I would like to make it clear that in any matter anyone should have the opportunity to have a fair chance to present issues without having to worry about relatives in the court system to get involved and be bias.
